Baby Articles - Woven articles like cloth diapers, muslins, bed-covers, quilts, quilt covers, duvets, sleeping bags, flat & fitted sheets, wash cloth/gloves, face cloth, bibs and hooded/cuddle towels made of 100% CO, 100% CV and CO/PES, in white, reactive dyed, pigment printed, khadi printed (CO and CO/PES only) and finished. Woven CO with CV as bamboo in weft articles in white, pigment printed and finished. Knitted articles like bed covers, jersey/knitted terry fitted sheets, sleeping bags, hooded/cuddle towels, bodysuits, baby pant/trouser, neckerchiefs, shoe covers, cleansing pads, baby chair covers, face cloth and bibs made of 100% CO, CO/elastane and CO/PES in white, reactive dyed (PES undyed), pigment printed (CO and CO/PES only) and finished. Including accessories: sewing and embroidery threads (embroidery without the use of interlinings), black or white elastic tapes, zippers, metal accessories and snaps, PES wadding, woven and printed labels. Made of certified materials according to STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX®

The results of the inspection made according to STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX®, Annex 6, **product class I** have shown that the above mentioned goods meet the human-ecological requirements of the STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX® presently established in Annex 6 for baby articles.

The certified articles fulfil requirements of Annex XVII of REACH (incl. the use of azo colourants, nickel release, etc.), the American requirement regarding total content of lead in children's articles (CPSIA; with the exception of accessories made from glass) and of the Chinese standard GB 18401:2010 (labelling requirements were not verified).

The holder of the certificate, who has issued a conformity declaration according to ISO 17050-1, is under an obligation to use STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX® mark only in conjunction with products that conform with the sample initially tested. The conformity is verified by audits.
